## **Congratulations to Rockingham and Kwinana for their beaches**

Kwinana Industries Council congratulates both the City of Rockingham (Western Australia's cleanest beach for 2010), and the Town of Kwinana for its High Commendation award for Wells Park at Kwinana Beach.
