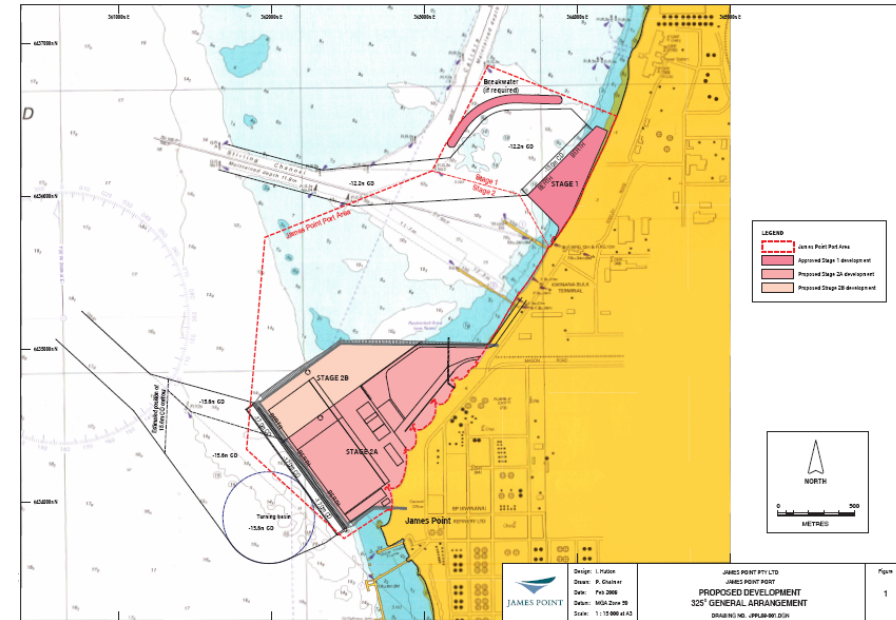

# Two significant developments

- **Bulk & General Facility:**  
Stakeholder Reference Group being established
- **International Container Facility:**  
EPA has approved the final Environmental Scoping Document



# Stakeholder Reference Group

- A condition of approval by Minister for Environment in 2004
- Role of the SRG is:
  - provision of advice to the Minister for the Environment on the environmental aspects of the construction and operation of the [Bulk & General] proposal generally;
  - provision of feedback and input into the preparation and standard of implementation of the environmental management plans and programs;
  - provision of advice and input into the mitigation for loss of coastal access, as a consequence of the proposal; and
  - provision of advice on the proponent's environmental performance.
- To commence in April, subject to nominations being received
