## Photo Comp Response

Budding photographers have responded to the Coastcare Coastal Photo Competition, sponsored by Kwinana Industries Council, but organiser Craig Wilson wants more applicants to join in.

"The response has been of a very high quality and it shows a high level of talent," Mr Wilson said.

Categories include best mobile phone pic – so taking part is as easy as snapping a pic and emailing it in, he said.

There are two other categories – Student and Open – and all entries must be of the coastal strip from Port Kennedy to Henderson and are to be submitted by email.

"Perhaps picture could include summer experiences in Cockburn Sound," he said.

"We are looking for photos of the plants, animals and scenery that people most enjoy and will be displaying the best entries," he said.

Sponsored by KIC, the photo competition is part of the larger Coastcare program which is re-vegetating the Kwinana Industrial Area (KIA) coastline.

The Coastcare Program, an initiative of the Swan Catchment Council, Local, State and the Australian Government, mobilizes community participation in the restoration of the coastal foreshore through the provision of training and on-ground support for community groups.

"The KIA has one of Western Australia's most beautiful coastlines and it is industry's aim to keep it that way," said **KIC director Chris Oughton**.

"By sponsoring programs like Coastcare we are making sure the area is vegetated with Australian species native to the area, which should also lead to an increase in native wildlife."
