Short Film Competition Conditions of Entry and Declaration Form

- Two Categories: Open and Student.
- Competition for amateur film makers only.
- The film must feature or relate to the Kwinana or Rockingham coast.
- One entry per person or one entry per school.
- Entrants to the Short Film Competition must provide a signed declaration with their entry.
- The film must run a maximum of 5 minutes including title and credits – there is no minimum length.
- Film edit programs such as Windows Movie Maker are easy to use and can be downloaded from the web.
- Film must be submitted on a DVD (Submitted DVD's will not be returned so you must retain a copy).
- Ensure that your DVD plays on a standard home DVD player before submission.
- It is recommended that you shoot your film on 16:9 ratio (Widescreen) where possible although 4:3 (Full screen) will be accepted.
- Films that are unlawful or of objectionable content will not be accepted.
- It will be the responsibility of the film maker to gain the required permissions, allowing him/her to submit films containing recognizable people.
- You must have written permission to use copyright music or use copyright free music that can be downloaded from the web.
- The film becomes the joint property of the KIC and the entrant permission.
- By participating, all entrants agree that the film may be used in promotional campaigns by the Kwinana Industries Council with the entrants consent.
- Entries must include the following text on the title page: "Beach Shoot" KIC Coastal Short Film and Photo Competition
- Competition closes Friday 19 March 2010.
- Winners only will be notified by Thursday 1 April.
- Winners will be invited to an Awards Night and Film Festival on Wednesday 7 April – all entrants and families are invited to attend along with members of the general public.
- The Film Festival will show the winning and other selected entries.
- Post your DVD and signed Declaration to Coastcare Officer, Town of Kwinana, PO Box 21 Kwinana, WA 6966 and include your contact details.

Photo Competition Conditions of Entry

- Three Categories: Student, Open and Mobile Phone Photo.
- Competition for amateur photographers only.
- The photo must be taken on the Kwinana or Rockingham coast.
- One entry per person.
- Entrants are to submit images which are their own original work.
- Each entry must contain the photographers name, date of birth and contact details, also date and location of photo, (school name and year class if applicable).
- It will be the responsibility of the photographer to gain the required permissions, allowing him/her to submit images containing recognizable people.
- Images that are unlawful or of objectionable content will not be accepted.
- Photo File must not exceed 3 MB in size.
- By participating, all entrants agree that selected images may be used in promotional campaigns by the Kwinana Industries Council and the Town of Kwinana.
- Competition closes Friday 19 March 2010.
- Winners only will be notified by Thursday 1 April.
- Winners will be invited to the Awards Night and Film Festival on Wednesday 7 April to accept their prizes – all entrants and families are invited to attend along with members of the general public.
