



## Facelift for Kwinana industrial area

**K**WINANA'S industrial area may receive a \$5 million face-lift courtesy of the State Government and Kwinana Town Council.

Streetscaping, public art and colourful trees and shrubs will feature in a project to beautify major roads around the area.

Kwinana Mayor Carol Adams said the beautification project was sure to make the drive to work more pleasant.

"This exciting project will change the face of the Kwinana industrial area," Cr Adams said.

"As well as those of us who live and work in the area, the travelling public and casual visitors will also reap the benefits of such a major aesthetic upgrade.

"The beautification work will include the planting of hundreds of native trees.

Flowers including peppermints, tuarts

and carpets of everlasting will also be added.

"Entry statements and signage, paving and kerbing, street furniture, art works and colour themes will combine to transform and enhance the Kwinana industrial area, as seen from the main routes.

"It's a very exciting and forward-looking plan for the Town of Kwinana."

Cr Adams said an attractive streetscape would help erase the perception held by some people that Kwinana was little more than an industrial zone.

"We have had initial meetings with Planning and Infrastructure Minister, Alannah MacTiernan and her response has been positive," she said.

"If the funding arrangement receives the go ahead from the State Government, work on this project could begin immediately."
